ORDER

As per the GO read 2nd above, the power of granting sanction of 3rd condonation to the students of Diploma course having shortage of attendance vested with the Government has been entrusted to a committee consisting of Director of Technical Education as Chairman, and Senior Joint Director (PS) and Joint Controller of Technical Examinations as members with direction to consider the case of 3rd condonation of students whose percentage of attendance is 60% and below 75%. The committee examined the applications for condonation received from various Polytechnic colleges and found that 16 students are eligible for 3rd condonation.

Sanction is therefore accorded to condone the shortage of attendance of the following students for the third time on medical grounds during the academic year 2018-19 subject to remittance of prescribed fees.


