<p><u>What is Cybersecurity?</u></p> <p>Cybersecurity is the practice of securing networks, systems and any other digital infrastructure from malicious attacks. With the increased rate of cyber crimes happening in the world today, it is no wonder that banks, tech companies, hospitals and government agencies are recognizing the importance of cyber security.</p> <p>There are different types of cyber attacks that affect thousands of people each day. Malware is one such frequent ways of cyber-attack. Malware is used to describe malicious software, including spyware, ransomware and viruses. It can come in the form of an email or an app. Once installed it can erase or take away the data stored in your computer. Phishing is another major form of cyber attack that people face today. Phishing refers to the practice of sending malicious communications designed to appear from reputable, well known sources. Once the phishing link is clicked, cyber criminals have access to sensitive data like credit cards, social security or login information. Social Engineering is the process of psychologically manipulating a person to reveal his personal information. For example, cyber criminals imitate a person’s voice and call his relatives and friends to get their password, credit card number etc.</p>		

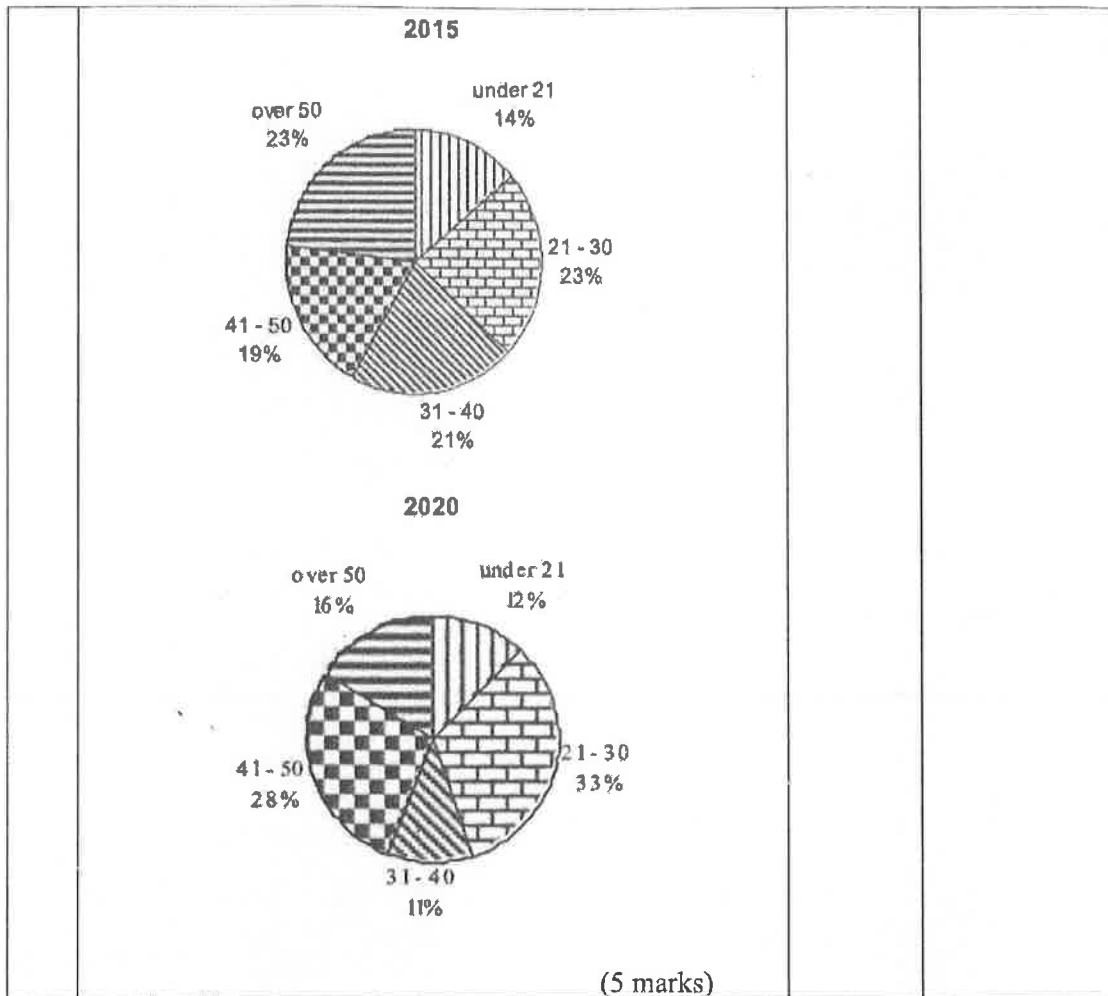
